Life in Lyndhurst: A Report from the Lyndhurst Community Organization

The Lyndhurst Community Organization (LCO) became active in 2024, building on the legacy of the now dissolved Lyndhurst Rejuvenation Committee (LRC). Things are happening in Lyndhurst!

Community Garden Success: One of our notable achievements is the establishment of the Lyndhurst Community Garden, led by the enthusiastic Colette Kenny and generously supported by local businesses and individuals. Special thanks to the township for a community grant that helped us get this garden off(in!) the ground.

A big thank you also to Spencer, the new owner of Lyndhurst Home Hardware, for allowing us to have the garden on his land. Since June, the garden has been providing healthy food to both the food bank and community members.

Spring Plant Sale & Main Street Beautification: Spring saw a successful plant sale, raising funds for the LCO – a huge thanks to all helpers & plant donors! Our volunteers repaired and restained the planters on Main Street, and early summer saw them filled with flowers by volunteers. Though we faced some challenges with watering, we are in discussions with the township to find better solutions.

Streetscape Improvements: We're collaborating with the township and the county to spruce up Lyndhurst's streetscape. The LCO board met with township staff and the county operations manager to discuss enhancements including benches, and crucial signage. Some good ideas were discussed. While government processes are slow, signs to help visitors and residents find amenities like toilets, the new viewing platform, and the canoe dock are moving up the agenda.

Traffic and Safety Initiatives: Our request for a resolution to lower the speed limit on County Road 33 was successfully taken to council, thanks to our diligent councillors. This, along with our petition has moved to County Council and is now pending a report from County Operations. The county's tender for traffic and pedestrian safety around the Lyndhurst Bridge has been awarded to CIMA Canada Inc. As part of the project, a questionnaire has been developed to gather input from residents and stakeholders. To participate go to [https://forms.office.com/r/ACzu12UV4z]

New Canoe Dock: Responding to our inquiries about the missing canoe dock, the township provided a new public canoe dock for Lyndhurst Lake – Thank-you township!

LRC Viewing Platform Project: After years of effort the LRC Viewing Platform Project has finally come to fruition. Lyndhurst now boasts a beautiful waterfront walk between Furnace Falls Park and Jonas Street with a viewing platform looking over Lyndhurst Creek, a result of a collaboration between the township and the LRC. Congratulations and thanks to Terri Dawson for championing this project to completion.

Ongoing Community Engagement: Throughout the year, we actively sought resident input on enhancing Lyndhurst and continue to refine our strategic plan based on feedback – a work in progress!

405 Property Maintenance: Following some discussion, the township agreed to keep the weeds cut back on the 405 property next to the heritage Lyndhurst Bridge, significantly improving its appearance. The costing for transforming this property into a park, as originally intended upon its purchase by the LRC and the township, is to be included in the upcoming township budget deliberations.

Special Thanks: No report from Lyndhurst would be complete without a huge thank you to the "Chamber of Commerce Turkey Fair Committee" for organizing another successful Turkey Fair. Keep an eye out for the upcoming Chamber of Commerce Santa Claus parade in November!
