

## "Canadian Wollastonite" - putting Seeley's Bay on the International Map!

Ever wonder what that mining operation just south of Seeley's Bay next to Hwy.15 was?



**W**ell, the rock there is a major source of wollastonite, which can <u>improve soil and increase crop yields</u>, as well as through rainfall, store significant quantities of greenhouse gasses!

The process is called Enhanced Rock Weathering (ERW) Weathering is a naturally occurring process that continuously erodes rocks while locking away  $CO_2$  that is stored in the atmosphere.

Canadian Wollastonite (CW), in partnership with the ERW company UNDO Carbon of the UK, are looking for partners to scale this nature-based solution here in Canada.

**CW President Bob Vasily** says "I believe ERW is one of the most promising carbon removal methods that sits in the goldilocks zone of scalability, cost, and carbon removal potential. What ERW companies do is they source exceed silicate rock, such as

nies do is they source <u>crushed</u> silicate rock, such as our wollastonite, and they spread it out on agricultural land. The fine rock dust weathers much quicker Atmospheric/Soil CO<sub>2</sub> because of the high exposed surface area & most importantly, permanently locks away that captured atmospheric carbon dioxide quickly."

He continues.. "The rocks used in ERW are nutrientrich and release beneficial elements into soils as they break down. This is why agricultural land is a logical place to deploy this solution, as it benefits farmers and agricultural communities."

Based on submissions made in Ottawa ".. field trial research has shown that ERW practices can improve soil structure, lower soil acidity, improve crop health and increase yields. Minerals like wollastonite can be spread on any type of cropland and can reduce the need for costly CO2-emitting lime inputs. With the capability of increasing outputs and decreasing the need for artificial fertilisers & lime, ERW can improve Canadian farmers' bottom lines."
